AEPC Livery Terms and Conditions

1. Hickstead Ltd agrees to provide Full/DIY Livery services, and the owner agrees to pay for the same, as stated in the Services & Pricing Schedule and in accordance with the Terms and Conditions as set out in paragraphs 2 and 10 below.
2. Hickstead Ltd reserves the rights to change the Services and Pricing Schedule and/or Terms and Conditions of the agreement by providing the owner one month's notice in writing.
3. Payment of ALL Livery charges shall be made monthly in advance, first payment due on horse(s) arrival. An invoice for supplementary services, eg. veterinary, farriery, worming etc. will be issued on a monthly basis and due for payment within ten working days of issue. If payment is not made by the due date(s) the owner will be considered to be in default and Hickstead Ltd may terminate the Agreement with immediate effect.
4. A deposit of two weeks DIY or Full Livery charge is payable on commencement of the Agreement and will be held in lieu of monies owing with the balance being refunded on cessation of the Agreement.
5. Hickstead Ltd or the owner, may terminate the Agreement by providing one months notice in writing. Notwithstanding the cause of termination of the Agreement, all sums due to Hickstead Ltd shall be paid, by cleared funds, prior to the removal of the horse(s) by the owner. Hickstead Ltd shall be entitled to retain the horse(s) at the agreed livery charge together with any tack and other equipment of the owner until such payment is made in full. If payment of sums due on termination of the Agreement is not made in full within 30 days, Hickstead Ltd reserves the right to sell the horse(s), tack and other equipment, as it shall in its absolute discretion think fit without further notice to the owner. From such proceeds of sale, Hickstead Ltd may deduct all sums due at the date the sale is completed together with any expenses concerning the sale and any other related expenditure of whatsoever nature.
6. The Owner warrants that the horse(s) is (are) in good health and free from injury, disease and vices with the following exceptions:

7. In the event Hickstead Ltd is unable to contact the Owner, having taken all reasonable steps to do so, the owner authorises Hickstead Ltd, at their absolute discretion, to call a Veterinary Surgeon, without further notice. The owner accepts full responsibility for the payment of all related fees.
8. Notwithstanding that Hickstead Ltd will take all reasonable steps to maintain security, horse(s), tack, equipment and vehicles are kept at the premises at the Owners risk.
9. Hickstead Ltd, undertakes to maintain Public Liability Insurance and to comply with H&SAW. The owner, agrees to insure their horse(s) for the Third Party Liability including liability for death and personal injury.
10. The Owner undertakes to inform Hickstead Ltd of any change of address or contact details.
