Entries are accepted from Exhibitors and Competitors who are allowed to compete only on the clear understanding that they agree to comply with and be bound by these Rules and Regulations and the Special Conditions relating to each class or competition.

- Late or nomination entries will not be accepted. All entries must be sent to The Secretary, All England Jumping Course, Hickstead, Sussex RH17 5NU, together with the correct amount of entry fees.
- where applicable, and will receive one groom's wristband per two horses, plus a horsebox pass for parking in the Stable Field. Exhibitors who are competing in a British Showjumping Winter Final only do not need to be members of Hickstead and will receive two day members passes for the owner and rider, one groom's wristband, plus a horsebox pass for parking in the stable field. One groom's wristband will be allocated per two horses. Passes will only be issued to exhibitors for the day they are exhibiting. Weekly stabling does not entitle exhibitors to a full quota of weekly passes. Extra passes will need to be purchased: SHOWJUMPING EXHIBITORS PASSES Owners and riders of horses in the jumping classes must be members of Hickstead only one weekly groom's wristband per two horses will be issued free of charge.

Exhibitors' passes are valid the day before their classes when overnight stabling is booked. Access is limited to the Stable Field only, and to the Showground, Trade Stand Village and Food Hall from 4.00pm.

Exhibitors may purchase extra passes in advance from the Hickstead Office Exhibitors and visitors parking in the Riders' Car Park at the top of the Stable Field near the exit will be charged £10 per day or £40 for the week. Bedding, Forage and Muck Removal: Please note that, due to fire regulations, straw is not permitted in the Stable Field. Exhibitors are advised to bring their own shavings - stables will not be bedded down in advance. Extra shavings, hay and forage can be purchased from Falcon Equine Feeds in the Stable Field on a daily basis. **Deliveries of forage and bedding from alternative suppliers will be strictly prohibited this year.** Due to the escalating environmental costs associated with muck removal and disposal, exhibitors will be charged £6.00 per stable to contribute towards the cost of this service. This does not relate to mucking out – please leave your stables clean and tidy after use! Failure to do so may result in future expulsion from Hickstead.



SHOW.JUMPING EXHIBITORS - IMPORTANT INFORMATION!

Amended Entries and Substitutions

Amended or additional entries, if accepted at the show, will be charged an additional £5.00 per class. Exhibitors changing to a different class during the show with a lower entry fee will forfeit the difference in fees. Failure to start in any classes will result in the forfeiture of the associated fees. Genuine substitutions for horses that have upgraded will not be subject to an additional fee unless there is a difference in the class entry fees. **Faxed or emailed entries (including amendments by email) will not be accepted. Should you wish to make amendments to your entries prior to the show please telephone the show office on 01273 834315.**

Payment of Entries / Exhibitor Accounts/MULTIPLE RIDER ACCOUNTS

Payment of entries, stabling and ancillary services must be settled in full at the time of entry - entry forms received without full payment will be returned to the exhibitor. Amendments to entries made prior to or during the show must be settled in full at the time the entries are amended. All exhibitors will be charged an entries' processing fee of £2.50 per entry form. EXHIBITORS/TRAINERS WITH MULTIPLE RIDERS ON THEIR ACCOUNT WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL FEES UNLESS SEPARATE ENTRY FORMS ARE SENT FOR EACH RIDER WITH PAYMENT AT THE TIME OF ENTRY. WE WILL NOT CHASE PAYMENT FROM INDIVIDUAL COMPETITORS – THIS IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ACCOUNT HOLDER.

Showing/Jumping Entries

Exhibitors submitting entries for both showjumping and showing competitions are required to do so on separate entry forms and enclose separate payments for each discipline. **They are processed in totally different departments.**

Access to the Showground

No horses or persons may come on to the showground before 10am on Tuesday, 19th June for the Al Shira'aa Hickstead Derby Meeting or before 10am on Monday 23rd July for the Longines FEI Jumping Nations CupTM of Great Britain at the BHS Royal International Horse Show. Due to persistent offenders compromising show preparations, any exhibitor breaching this rule will be fined £100.00 per horse per night.

Deliveries of Forage / Bedding

Exhibitors may bring their own forage and shavings; alternatively, both are available to purchase at Hickstead from the Falcon Equine Feeds Centre within the Stable Field. **Deliveries of forage and bedding from alternative suppliers will be strictly prohibited this year.**

Muck Removal And Disposal

Due to the escalating environmental costs associated with muck removal and disposal, exhibitors will be charged £6.00 per stable to contribute towards the cost of this service. This charge does not pertain to mucking out and exhibitors are required to leave their stables clean and tidy after use.

Electric Hook-Up

Electric hook-up will be available allocated <u>strictly</u> on a first come, first served basis. Reservations for electric hook-up cannot be made in advance and exhibitors are to arrange this with the Stable Manager upon arrival at Hickstead. Regrettably, only cash payment can be accepted in the Stable Field although VAT receipts will be issued upon request. The cost of hook-up is £85 for the Al Shira'aa Hickstead Derby Meeting and £95 for the Longines FEI Jumping Nations CupTM of Great Britain at the BHS Royal International Horse Show. Exhibitors are strongly advised to bring along extensive electric cable for this purpose; a minimum length cable of 30m is the recommended.

Stabling of Stallions

Stallion owners are obliged to provide their own electric packs. Failure to do so will result in exhibitors having to purchase a pack from the Stable Manager at a cost of £200 per unit. Unruly or dangerous animals may be asked to leave the showground.

Receipt of Entries

Due to the high volume of entries, it is not possible to confirm receipt of entries via telephone. Any exhibitor wishing to receive confirmation of receipt should include a stamped addressed postcard with their entries.

Emergency Contact Details/Horseboxes

Please ensure that you write your mobile telephone number on your horsebox pass (to be displayed in the front of your lorry) so that the Stable Manager is able to contact you in the event of an emergency. It is prohibited for any exhibitor or associate to interfere with another exhibitor's horsebox.

Riders' Car Park

Exhibitors and visitors parking in the Riders' Car Park at the top of the Stable field near the exit will be charged £10 per day or £30 for the week for the Al Shira'aa Hickstead Derby Meeting or £40 for the Longines FEI Jumping Nations CupTM of Great Britain at the BHS Royal International Horse Show. Car Passes can be purchased in advance or on the day.
