



# THE 53rd HURSTPIERPOINT COLLEGE NATIONAL PONY CLUB JUMPING CHAMPIONSHIPS

## HICKSTEAD

### Thursday 2nd August 2018

#### RULES GOVERNING THE CHAMPIONSHIPS

- 1 Speed 325m per minute. To be judged under Pony Club rules. Table A.
- 2 EACH PONY CLUB MAY ENTER ONLY ONE TEAM. Each area may enter not more than three teams which may be selected if desired at a Regional qualifying competition. It is not obligatory to hold a Regional qualifying competition.
- 3 Each team will consist of three or four paid-up Members of the same branch.
- 4 All horses/ponies are eligible for this Championship except the combination of horse and rider are not eligible if they have achieved a double clear in BE or SJI competitions where any of the fences were above 1.30m in the first round.
- 5 Entries will be made by the District Commissioner or Secretary of the Branch. Nomination entries will not be accepted, but substitutions will be allowed at the time of declaration. ALL TEAMS MUST DECLARE EITHER BY TELEPHONE (01273 834315) OR AT THE SECRETARY'S OFFICE BY 5.30 pm THE DAY BEFORE.
- 6 Maximum height of fences in the preliminary round 1.15m.
- 7 No horse or rider may compete in more than one pony club team, and no horse or rider may compete more than once in the same team. Horses and/or riders may compete in the Schools Jumping Championships (schedules available on request – no qualification required).
- 8 This Championship will be decided as follows:
  - (i) There will be a preliminary competition in Ring 2 at 8.30 am. Each complete team will enter the ring, and start in jumping card order. Each rider will go through the start and finish and will NOT start before the bell. Each rider will jump one round only. The other members of the team will wait in a holding box in the ring until it is their turn to jump. The score of the team will be found by adding together the faults of the best three riders in each team. The eight highest placed teams will go forward to the final in the International Arena. If the number of teams on equal faults exceeds eight, places in the finals will be decided by a jump-off. Teams will nominate one rider to jump off against the clock.
  - (ii) The final will take place in the International Arena. In the final, the team with the most faults in the preliminary competition will start first, and the team with the least, last. The number one rider from each team will jump first, followed by the number two rider, and so on. FAULTS INCURRED IN THE PRELIMINARY COMPETITION WILL NOT BE CARRIED FORWARD TO THE FINAL. In any round, if a rider is eliminated his score will not count. In the event of a tie for first place, there will be one jump-off against the clock.
  - (iii) At the conclusion of the Pony Club Team Jumping Championship, there will be an Individual Championship. This is only open to those competitors who have qualified to jump in the Team Finals in the International Arena. All competitors who jump a clear round in the Team Finals in the International Arena will go forward to a timed jump-off. If there are no clear rounds, the best scores, e.g. the four faulters, from the first round will jump-off. In the event of there being only 2 to jump-off, the third placing will be decided on faults and time in the first round in the International Arena. If a jump-off is needed to decide the Team Championships, the scores of any eligible individuals involved in that jump-off will count towards the Individual placings, i.e. they will not jump-off again. There will be three individual placings.
  - (iv) Immediately after the Pony Club Team & Individual Championships, there will be a parade of ALL teams in the International Arena, where each rider will receive a rosette.

- 9 Jackets, jodhpurs or breeches, boots and hats in line with current pony club rules must be worn. Hats must be worn with the chin strap correctly fastened at all times when mounted, including during the prize giving. Hat covers must be dark blue or black.
- 10 The General Rules and Regulations governing competitions at Hickstead will apply (see back of Entry Form).

**STABLING** will be available at £35.00 per night, per box. No horses/ponies will be admitted to the showground before 4.00pm on Tuesday 31st July 2018.

## GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

Intending Exhibitors and Competitors are particularly requested to peruse these Rules and Regulations carefully in addition to the Special Conditions applicable to the various classes and competitions. Entries are accepted from Exhibitors and Competitors who are allowed to compete only on the clear understanding that they agree to comply with and be bound by these Rules and Regulations and the Special Conditions relating to each class or competition.

1. All entries must be sent to The Secretary, All England Jumping Course, Hickstead, West Sussex RH17 5NU, together with the correct amount of entry fees.

2. **FORFEITURE OF FEES AND CHARGES** Failure to exhibit any animal entered will entail forfeiture of entry fees and all other charges other than in accordance with British Showjumping rules. Should any competition be cancelled because of bad weather or any reason, entry fees will be refunded. It is regretted that stabling and other charges cannot be refunded.

3. Teams must jump in the order in which they appear in the programme, unless special permission has been obtained from the Executive.

4. During the competition **THREE TEAMS MUST ALWAYS BE READY TO ENTER THE RING**. If a team does not respond when it is called, it loses its turn, and may be eliminated from the Competition in progress.

5. The Executive reserves the right to cancel, add to, or amend any of the competitions as they think fit.

6. The Executive reserves the right to remove any vehicle which is obstructing any access to, or on the showground even if locked and unattended, and the Executive will not be liable for injury, loss or damage occasioned by such removal.

7. **HORSEBOXES** - It is a requirement to put your mobile telephone number on your horsebox pass which must be displayed in the windscreen. It is prohibited for any exhibitor or associate to interfere with another exhibitor's horsebox.

8. **SHAVINGS** are available for purchase at Hickstead in the Stable Field, or exhibitors may bring their own. It is regretted that straw is banned from the Stable Field due to Fire Regulations.

9. Any competitor found riding in the ring without permission will be disqualified from the show. All warming up must be done in the area provided.

10. Neither the All England Jumping Course nor the Executive nor Hickstead Limited nor any of them nor any of its or their officers, servants or agents shall be in any way liable for any accidents, injury, damage, loss or for anything that may happen (from any cause or circumstances whatsoever) to exhibitors, competitors or members or their servants, agents or to anyone on the show ground or to any animal or article exhibited or to any property brought on to the showground or for any other loss, claim, matter, circumstances or event whatsoever in connection with, or arising out of, or attributable to the show or any journey to or from the show, the Executive of Hickstead Limited or any of them or its or their officers, servants or agents of these or any other Rules and Regulations or Special Conditions prescribed by them.

11. **THE EXECUTIVE MAY IN ANY DISPUTE OR OTHER MATTER WHATSOEVER, ACT OR DECIDE IN ANY MANNER THEY THINK FIT.**
