2018 heralds the 55th anniversary of the Hurstpierpoint College National Schools Jumping Championships at the All England Jumping Course at Hickstead. These finals will be held along with the National Pony Club Jumping Championships on Thursday 2nd August 2018.

Please note that there are some important changes for this year. For the first time, schools teams will be open to four riders, with the best three scores to count. The Junior Division has also been reduced in height to 90cms. With the Hickstead NSEA Championships and a new individual competition taking place the previous day, we hope as many of you as possible will make the journey to compete at our prestigious venue.

We are delighted that Hurstpierpoint College have agreed to continue their sponsorship of these Championships. Located only three miles from Hickstead, Hurst uses our facilities for their equestrian activities and is a keen supporter of our international events.

Hickstead is affiliated to the National Schools Equestrian Association (NSEA), and we strongly recommend that schools become members, not least for the insurance cover the Association offers. For membership details and more information, please visit their website www.nsea.org.uk

The Junior Schools Team and Individual Finals will take place at 11.00am, the Pony Club Team and Individual Finals at approximately 1.00pm, followed by the Senior Schools Team and Individual Finals at approximately 3.00pm. There will be a separate awards ceremony for each division. The prize giving and a parade of ALL participating teams (even those who failed to qualify for the International Arena) will take place after each Final. Every rider will receive a Hickstead rosette.

International Arena

2.15pm THE HICKSTEAD 1.00m NSEA TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP (SECOND ROUND) Single Phase
Under NSEA General Rules 2017-2018. Speed 325mpm. To be judged under Hickstead and British Showjumping rules. Maximum height of fences 1.05m. **OPEN TO THE TOP 6 TEAMS BASED ON THE BEST THREE SCORES IN THE FIRST ROUND.** All four riders will be eligible to compete in the second round. Scores from the first round will be carried forward. In the International Arena, the number one rider from each team will jump first, followed by the number two rider, and so on. For qualification purposes, and for final placings, faults & time will decide.

PRIZES: A Hickstead rug to each winning rider, rosettes and prizes in kind to 6th place

Class 1 THE HICKSTEAD ELITE NSEA INDIVIDUAL CHAMPIONSHIP Single Phase

3.45pm Speed 325m per minute. To be judged under Hickstead and British Showjumping rules. Maximum height of fences 1.10m. Open to 20 ponies & 20 horses who have qualified at one of the NSEA qualifying competitions. Horses/ponies of any height or grade. Ponies will jump first, followed by the horses (distances will be altered). The final classification will be decided on faults and time across both sections, i.e. the class will not be split by ponies & horses.

ENTRY FEE: £35

PRIZES: The winning rider will receive a lesson with Shane Breen, plus a Hickstead rug, rosettes and prizes in kind to 8th place

Class 2 THE HICKSTEAD 1.00m NSEA TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP (FIRST ROUND) Single Phase

10.00am Under NSEA General Rules 2017-2018. Open to teams of **FOUR** riders from the same school, under 19 years of age on **1st September 2018** who have attended the school entering the team during the previous Summer Term. 30 teams to qualify from 15 qualifiers (two to qualify from each). Substitutions will be allowed at the time of declaration (according to NSEA rules). Maximum height of fences in the first round 1.00m (this may be increased to 1.05m in the second round). Each complete team will enter the ring, and start in jumping card order. Each rider will go through the start and finish and will NOT start before the bell. Each rider will jump one round only. The other members of the team will wait in a holding box in the ring until it is their turn to jump. The score of the team will be found by adding together the faults of the best three riders in the team – the worst score will be dropped. **The top 6 teams based on the best three scores in the first round will qualify for a second round in the International Arena.** All four riders will be eligible to compete in the second round. For qualification purposes, faults and time will decide. Scores from the first round will be carried forward. In the International Arena, the number one rider from each team will jump first, followed by the number two rider, and so on.

Class 3 HICKSTEAD 80-85cms INDIVIDUAL SCHOOLS COMPETITION Single Phase

2.00pm Open to individual riders competing in the Hurstpierpoint College National Schools Jumping Championships or the NSEA Championships at Hickstead. Maximum height of fences 85cms.

ENTRY FEE: £20

PRIZES: The winning rider will receive a Hickstead rug and stable plaque, rosettes to 8th place

RULES GOVERNING THESE CHAMPIONSHIPS

- 1 All teams and individual riders must declare either by telephone (01273 834315) or at the Show Office by 5.30pm the day before (31st July).
- 2 The Hickstead Organising Committee reserves the right to award wildcards to the competition, to make up the numbers if necessary and as they see fit.
- 3 **STABLING** is available on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday at £35.00 per box per night. No horses/ponies will be admitted to the showground before 4.00pm on Tuesday 31st July 2018.
- 4 All riders and/or horses may also compete in The Hurstpierpoint College National Schools Jumping Championships and/or The Hurstpierpoint College National Pony Club Jumping Championships on Thursday 2nd August.
- 5 Jackets, jodhpurs or breeches, boots and hats in line with current pony club or BS rules must be worn. It is requested that riders should have their school crest, colour or other identification on their saddle-cloths, or wear school blazers in their school colours.
- 6 The General Rules and Regulations governing competitions at Hickstead will apply (see back of Entry Form).
- 7 The Executive has the right to refuse an entry without giving a reason, and may in any dispute or other matter whatsoever, act or decide in any manner they think fit.

RULES GOVERNING THE CHAMPIONSHIPS

- 1 Speed 325m per minute. Table A. To be judged under Hickstead and British Showjumping rules, with the exception of Rule 212.2. The third refusal will incur elimination.
- 2 Open to any school, for teams of **FOUR** horses/ponies of any height or grade.
- 3 Nomination entries will not be accepted, but substitutions will be allowed at the time of declaration. ALL TEAMS MUST DECLARE EITHER BY TELEPHONE (01273 834315) OR AT THE SHOW OFFICE BY 5.30PM THE DAY BEFORE.
- 4 Maximum height of fences in the preliminary round **90cms** for the Junior Division, and 1.05m for the Senior Division.
- 5 No horse or rider may compete in more than one schools team (Junior or Senior), and no horse or rider may compete more than once in the same team. Riders and/or horses may compete in a Pony Club Team, provided they are qualified. If teams choose to bring a reserve rider, they must be clearly identified at the time of declaration, and may only jump at the end of the preliminary round when all teams have completed.
- 6 The Competition will be run in two divisions:
 - (a) THE JUNIOR DIVISION for riders under 14 years of age on **1st January 2018**, who have attended the school entering the team during the previous Summer Term.
 - (b) THE SENIOR DIVISION for riders under 19 years of age on **1st September 2018** who have attended the school entering the team during the previous Summer Term.
- 7 The Championship will be decided as follows:
 - (i) There will be a preliminary competition in Rings 3 and 4 at 8.30 am sharp. Each complete team will enter the ring, and start in jumping card order. Each rider will go through the start and finish and will NOT start before the bell. Each rider will jump one round only. The other members of the team will wait in a holding box in the ring until it is their turn to jump. The score of the team will be found by adding together the faults of the best three riders in the team – the worst score will be dropped. The ten highest placed teams in each division will go forward to the final in the International Arena. If the number of teams on equal faults exceeds ten, places in the finals will be decided by a jump-off. Teams will nominate one rider to jump off against the clock.
 - (ii) The finals will take place in the International Arena. In the final, the team with the most faults in the preliminary competition will start first, and the team with the least, last. The number one rider from each team will jump first, followed by the number two rider, and so on. **FAULTS INCURRED IN THE PRELIMINARY COMPETITION WILL NOT BE CARRIED FORWARD TO THE FINAL.** In any round if a rider is eliminated he will incur the worse score in the round plus 20 faults. In the event of a tie for first place, there will be one jump-off against the clock.
 - (iii) At the conclusion of each Schools Jumping Team Championship, there will be an Individual Championship. These Individual Championships are only open to those competitors who have qualified to jump in the Team Finals in the International Arena. All competitors who jump a clear round in the Team Finals in the International Arena will go forward to a timed jump-off. If there are no clear rounds, the best scores, e.g. the four faulters, from the first round will jump-off. In the event of there being only 2 to jump-off, the third placing will be decided on faults and time in the first round in the International Arena. If a jump-off is needed to decide the Team Championships, the scores of any eligible individuals involved in that jump-off will count towards the Individual placings, i.e. they will not jump-off again. There will be three individual placings in each division.
 - (iv) There will be a separate awards ceremony in the International Arena for each division. The Team & Individual prizegivings and a parade of all participating teams will take place after each Final. Every rider will receive a rosette.
- 8 Jackets, jodhpurs or breeches, boots and hats in line with current pony club or BS rules must be worn. It is requested that riders should have their school crest, colour or other identification on their saddle-cloths, or wear school blazers in their school colours. **SASHES MAY BE WORN BUT NOT IN THE PRIZE-GIVING CEREMONY.**

Entries are accepted from Exhibitors and Competitors who are allowed to compete only on the clear understanding that they agree to comply with and be bound by these Rules and Regulations and the Special Conditions relating to each class or competition.

1. All entries must be sent to The Secretary, All England Jumping Course, Hickstead, West Sussex RH17 5NU, together with the correct amount of entry fees.

2. **FORFEITURE OF FEES AND CHARGES** Failure to exhibit any animal entered will entail forfeiture of entry fees and all other charges other than in accordance with British Showjumping rules. Should any competition be cancelled because of bad weather or any reason, entry fees will be refunded. It is regretted that stabling and other charges cannot be refunded.

3. Teams must jump in the order in which they appear in the programme, unless special permission has been obtained from the Executive.

4. During the competition **THREE TEAMS MUST ALWAYS BE READY TO ENTER THE RING.** If a team does not respond when it is called, it loses its turn, and may be eliminated from the Competition in progress.

5. The Executive reserves the right to cancel, add to, or amend any of the competitions as they think fit.

6. The Executive reserves the right to remove any vehicle which is obstructing any access to, or on the showground even if locked and unattended, and the Executive will not be liable for injury, loss or damage occasioned by such removal.
