- 1. Please note this Premier League is to be run at the All England Jumping Course, Hickstead, with stabling and arenas in a different area of the showground to the former Dressage at Hickstead site. Please follow access directions carefully.
- 2. ALL ENTRIES MUST BE MADE ONLINE at www.hickstead.co.uk/entries-results-schooling/the-all-england-dressage-festival/
- 3. BREEDING: We would encourage every competitor to add the breeding of the horse(s) they are entering (especially Young Horse classes).
- **4.** LAURENT PERRIER CLUB: Located overlooking the Coldstream Equestrian Arena with indoor and outdoor seating and unparalleled views of all of the action. Sit back with a drink from the Champagne Bar or a bite to eat from the private deli/café £25 (£15 on Thursday) per person per day or £50 per person for the duration. Book online with entries.
- 5. HOOK UP is available for the duration of the show only (£110 per horsebox or caravan) and can only be booked online.
- 6. STABLING is available for the duration of the show and can be booked online only. All stabling will be on the showground in either permanent or temporary boxes. The permanent stables may have some bedding in them from previous use. No horses or persons may come on the showground before 12 noon on 11th May. Due to fire regulations, it is regretted that straw is banned from the Stable Field. Stables will not be bedded down in advance. Extra shavings can be purchased in the Stable Field on a daily basis at £12 per bale on the day (£10 per bale if booked prior to close of entries online only). Competitors are expected to leave their stables in a clean state, with muck removed and banked to the rear. A £10 returnable deposit will be payable on arrival to cover the clean stable check.

Permanent Stables (may have some bedding) 10'x10': £55 one night; £125 duration

Permanent Stables (may have some bedding) 10'x8': £40 one night; £100 duration

- 7. HORSEBOXES. It is a requirement to put your mobile number on your horsebox pass which must be displayed in the windscreen.
- 8. UNACCOMPANIED COMPETITORS must provide the Dressage Secretary with a contact mobile number in case of an emergency.
- 9. ACCOMMODATION. Please follow this link to find hotels, holiday cottages and B&B in the local area Where to stay (hickstead.co.uk)
- 10. GENERAL EXERCISE. There will be a general exercise arena available for use. Details to be confirmed.
- 11. ARENA WALKS. There will be time for arena walks and arena familiarisation during the show. Details to be confirmed.
- 12. FARRIER AND VETERINARY SURGEON. There will be an on-call veterinary surgeon. Further details to be provided at the Show.
- 13. DAY HORSE BOXES. These must be parked in the Stable Field.
- 14. FOOD AND BEVERAGE The Clubhouse Bar & Grill will be open for breakfast, lunch and dinner from Thursday 12th May.
- **15.** TIMES will be published on the Hickstead website www.hickstead.co.uk/entries-results-schooling/the-all-england-dressage-festival/ from 13.00 on 10th May 2022.
- **16.** CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES. Please note that entries must be received by the Secretary (via the online system) no later than Friday 29th April 2022.
- 17. ACCESS for horseboxes is via the A23 and Hickstead Lane only using postcode RH17 5NU. Access for cars is again via the A23 but using postcode BN6 9NS.

DIRECTIONS (HORSEBOXES ONLY) POSTCODE RH17 5NU

From the north - Postcode RH17 5NU

Travel south on the A23. Take the slip road off the A23 towards Burgess Hill A2300 towards Hickstead Village/Ricebridge. At the roundabout take the 4th exit back over the A23. At the roundabout, go straight ahead onto Hickstead Lane then immediately turn left into the private entrance and follow the signs for Horseboxes/Stable Field.

From the south - Postcode RH17 5NU

Leave the A23 at the first turning past Hickstead, signposted A2300 for Burgess Hill. At the top of the slip road, turn left at the roundabout into Hickstead Lane, then immediately turn left into the private entrance and follow the signs for Horseboxes/Stable Field.

DIRECTIONS (CARS) POSTCODE BN6 9NS

From the north - Postcode BN6 9NS

Travel south on the A23. Do <u>not</u> take the Burgess Hill / Hickstead Village turn-off, but take the next exit for the B2118 signposted Hickstead Showground and bear right over the fly-over. Take the third exit off the roundabout. The entrance to the showground is approximately 100 metres on the left.

From the south - Postcode BN6 9NS

Leave the A23 at the junction marked B2118 to Hurstpierpoint. At the top of the slip road, turn left. After 200 metres, turn right onto the B2118. Follow the B2118 for approximately 2.5 miles. The entrance to the showground is approximately 100 metres on the left, after the third roundabout.

HICKSTEAD GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. VEHICLES

The Executive reserves the right to remove any vehicle which is obstructing any access to or from the ground even if locked and unattended and the Executive will not be liable for any injury, loss or damage occasioned by such removal.

2. MOTORBIKES AND BICYCLES

In the interests of safety of competitors and members of the public, the riding of motor cycles, mopeds, electric scooters etc., is FORBIDDEN anywhere on the Hickstead Showground. Anybody contravening this rule will be sent off the showground. Bicycles may be ridden from the Stable Field to the Warm-Up Arenas.

3. FIRE PRECAUTION

The County Fire Officer of West Sussex has ordered that all horseboxes and caravans parked in the Stable Field must carry a fire extinguisher. You may be asked to leave if you do not have one.

4. CARAVANS AND LIVED-IN HORSE BOXES

Exhibitors with generators on their horseboxes must turn them off by 10.00pm. The Stable Field Security will strictly enforce this ruling. Exhibitors who fail to comply will be asked to leave the showground.

Please read carefully the General Rules and Regulations. Any person coming to Hickstead or involved in any aspects of the meeting is deemed to be bound by the General Rules and Regulations and all indemnities and undertakings required.
