NEW PASSES COLLECTION SYSTEM

The Passes' Office will be open between 6.30am and 8.00pm daily

All passes will now be collected onsite in the new Passes' Office located at the bottom of the Stable Field by the Hickstead Shop. All passes (purchased and show allocation) associated with individual EquiLive accounts will be sent as e-tickets to the registered email address 5 days prior to the start of the show. You will receive an entrance e-ticket that will be scanned to gain entry into the Stable Field only, and a collection e-voucher to exchange for your accreditation. It is the account holder's responsibility to distribute the e-tickets to the correct person. There is a zero-liability policy in place for those arriving without an e-ticket valid for the Stable Field. Those arriving without a valid e-ticket will be checked for exhibitor association and then issued with a temporary ticket which will be charged at the cost of a weekly wristband. This charge can only be reimbursed at the Passes' Office once a valid e-ticket has been produced or purchased and exchanged for a pass. Passes must be collected by the individual ticket holder so that the pass can be placed directly onto the wrist. There is no access to the Showground with an e-ticket; you must have collected your pass prior to leaving the Stable Field. Additional passes can be purchased at the Passes' Office, or in advance via your EquiLive account. Strictly no passes are to be left on any gate for collection.

PASS ALLOCATION FOR SHOWJUMPING EXHIBITORS

Owners and riders of horses in the jumping classes must be members of Hickstead where applicable and purchased at the time of entry. One Groom's wristband per two horses, plus a Horsebox Pass for parking in the Stable Field will be allocated. Exhibitor passes will only be issued for the day of competition. If weekly stables are purchased through your EquiLive account, one weekly groom's pass will be allocated per two weekly stables.

PASS ALLOCATION FOR SHOWING EXHIBITORS

Showing exhibitors will receive one Member's wristband per rider, and one Owner's Member's wristband per horse, plus a Horsebox Pass for the Stable Field. In addition, one groom's wristband will be allocated per two horses. Exhibitors may upgrade to a Member's wristband and/or purchase extra passes in advance via their EquiLive account. Exhibitor passes will only be issued for the day of competition. If weekly stables are purchased through your EquiLive account, one weekly groom's pass will be allocated per two weekly stables.

Cardboard swing badges are no longer permitted in the Stable Field. Members' Enclosure passes will be issued to exhibitors as fabric wristbands which grant access to both the Members' Enclosure and the Stable Field. Only Members' passes purchased through an EquiLive account, and collected at the Passes' Office, are valid in the Stable Field.

BACK NUMBERS FOR SHOWING COMPETITORS

This year we will not be supplying competitor back numbers and will require all showing competitors to use reusable back numbers. These can be purchased alongside your entries on EquiLive and collected at the show, or at the Show Office. Please note, any showing competitor without a back number will be refused entry into the show ring.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR INTERNATIONAL RIDERS

HORSE INSPECTION

A Horse Inspection will be carried out in the International Stabling Compound between 15.30 and 18.30 hours on Wednesday 17th June. All horses taking part at this event must be presented during the first horse inspection otherwise they are not permitted to participate (FEI rule).

RULES FOR SHOWJUMPING EXHIBITORS

SUBSTITUTIONS AND LATE ENTRIES

Substitutions may be allowed in jumping classes at the discretion of the OC, provided the animal substituted is in the same ownership. If an animal is upgraded, it may be transferred to another appropriate class. Late and amended entries, if taken at the show, will be charged an extra £5 per class.

ORDER OF JUMPING

Horses and ponies must jump in the order in which they appear on the Notice Board or starting sheet, unless special permission has been obtained from the Lead Official. Any competitor missing their turn may be eliminated from the competition. Three competitors must always be ready to enter the arena. If a competitor does not respond when they are called, they lose their turn and may be eliminated from the competition.

JUNIOR MEMBERS

Junior Members are only permitted to compete on horses from the calendar year in which the age of 12 is reached.

UNACCOMPANIED COMPETITORS

Unaccompanied competitors must provide the Show Organiser with a contact telephone number in case of an emergency.

DECLARATIONS

Competitors in national classes must declare at the ringside before the start of their class, EXCEPT for the first class in each ring and the 1.00m Open classes which will be drawn orders. If there are no competitors waiting to jump or no numbers on the blackboard, the judges will close the class. Please ensure that you arrive early. Declarations for classes in the International Arena must be made by 5.00pm on the previous evening.

QUALIFYING FOR THE INTERNATIONAL ARENA

All starting fees will be taken at the Show Office. Starting fees are taken as declarations. Entries for all national classes are confined to registered horses/ponies to be ridden by members in accordance with Rule 79.

STALLIONS

"Rule 82.19 No member shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete, in any show jumping competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other members of the public are not put at risk of injury". Also refer to Rule 102.13.

RULES FOR SHOWING EXHIBITORS

HEIGHT

Official Measurement Certificates issued under the Joint Measurement Scheme of the BSHA, NPS and the BSPS must be produced if requested. All horses must be properly shod except the in-hand classes.

HACKS, COBS, AND RIDING HORSES

These classes are being held under the rules of the British Show Horse Association. Horses must be registered with the Association, and all owners, producers and riders must be Association Members. Riders must be 15 years of age or older. Registration numbers must be quoted on the entry. This is a qualifying show for the Agria Royal International Horse Show 2026 and the first prizewinner in classes 144, 145, 146, 147, 148, 149 and 150 will qualify. If already qualified, qualification will be passed down the line. No horse lower than third may qualify. Horses competing at qualifying shows in the Hunter Sections of SHB(GB) classes at their affiliated shows cannot compete in Hack, Cobs, and Riding Horse Classes at the same show and vice versa. This does not apply to SHB(GB) Ridden Sport Horse classes. The highest placed unqualified exhibit in the top 5 in each Open affiliated class will qualify to compete in the BSHA Classic of the Year Final. The Finals will be held at the BSHA National Championship Shows in September 2026. The BSHA offer a Novice, Young Rider and Amateur rosette in each Open class and a Champion rosette for each section.

HUNTERS

These classes are being held under the rules of Sport Horse Breeding GB. Horses, riders & owners to be registered with SHB(GB) and have current annual Show Hunter Registration or Day Ticket. Riders must be 15 years of age or older. Registration numbers must be quoted on entry form. Classes 169, 170, 171, 172 and 173 are qualifying classes for the Agria Royal International Horse Show 2026. The first prizewinner in each class will qualify. If already qualified, qualification will pass down the line. In classes 169 - 172 qualification will not pass below fifth place. In class 173, qualification will not pass below third place. Judges shall have the power to transfer exhibits to a different class if they deem it necessary.

COLOURED HORSE CLASSES

This show is affiliated to CHAPS (UK). Exhibitors are asked to pay particular attention to the rulings printed above Class 191.

MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND MINI CLASSES

These classes are being held under BSPS rules. The highest placed pony, not already qualified, from the first three in each class will qualify for the Agria Royal International Horse Show 2026.

MOBILE PHONES

The use of mobile phones in the ring is prohibited. Anyone using a mobile phone in the ring will be asked to leave the ring.

SHOWING EXHIBITORS' NUMBERS

This year we will not be supplying competitor back numbers and will require all showing competitors to use reusable back numbers. These can be purchased alongside your entries on EquiLive and collected at the show, or at the Show Office. Please note, any showing competitor without a back number will be refused entry into the show ring.

SHOWING GROOMS' DRESS

Grooms must be correctly dressed when entering the arena, i.e., hat and jacket, and no denim. Anyone deemed inappropriately dressed will not be allowed to enter the ring.

EQUINE INFLUENZA VACCINATION CERTIFICATES

All horses and ponies entering the Showground must be vaccinated according to the following requirements, and vaccination certificates/passports must accompany the horse or pony to the show and be available for checking: Horses/ponies must have received two injections for primary vaccination against equine influenza given no less than 21 days and no more than 92 days apart. Only these two injections need to have been given before a horse/pony can compete in competitions. In addition, a first booster injection must be given no less than 150 days and no more than 215 days after the second injection of the primary vaccination. Subsequently, booster injections must be given at intervals of not more than one year apart. Horses/ponies must have received the full course of vaccinations or the booster at least 7 days prior to the competition date, and not more than 1 year after the previous booster. There will be no tolerance of Equine Influenza vaccination certificates that do not meet show protocol. If discrepancies are found, this will result in the horse being sent home immediately, without competing and/or any prizes will be forfeited.

Horses competing in FEI Events must comply with the requirements for Equine Influenza vaccination in accordance with FEI Veterinary Regulations.

HICKSTEAD GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

1. FORFEITURE OF FEES AND CHARGES

If entries are cancelled after the closing date, half the entry fee will be refunded on production of a current vet's certificate. We regret no stabling charges can be refunded (other than in accordance with British Showjumping Rules). Should any competition be cancelled because of bad weather or for any reason, entry fees will be refunded. It is regretted that stabling and other charges cannot be refunded.

2. DRESS

International Jumping: In accordance with FEI Rules. National Jumping: In accordance with British Showjumping Rule 101. Showing: In accordance with the rules of the relevant showing society.

3. VAT RATES

All entry fees are exempt from VAT. Stabling, membership, extra passes, first aid and starting fees are inclusive of VAT at the standard rate.

4. TIMETABLE AND CLASS LISTS

The Organising Committee reserves the right to move classes to other rings or change times as they think fit. Riders whose horses are not stabled at Hickstead are strongly advised to check the Hickstead website www.hickstead.co.uk after 8.00pm for revised times.

5. VEHICLES

The Executive reserves the right to remove any vehicle which is obstructing any access to or from the ground even if locked and unattended and the Executive will not be liable for any injury, loss or damage occasioned by such removal.

6. MOTORBIKES, BICYCLES & ELECTRIC SCOOTERS

In the interests of safety of competitors and members of the public, the riding of bicycles, motorcycles, electric scooters, mopeds, etc. is FORBIDDEN anywhere on the Hickstead Showground. Anybody contravening this rule will be sent off the Showground.

7. FIRE PRECAUTION

The County Fire Officer of West Sussex has ordered that all horse boxes and caravans parked in the Stable Field must carry a fire extinguisher and be fitted with a working smoke alarm. You may be asked to leave if you are without them.

8. STABLING

Stabling will be made available for the period of the show only. No access to the showground before 10.00am on Tuesday 16th June. Due to fire regulations, it is regretted that straw is banned from the Stable Field. Stables will not be bedded down in advance. Due to the escalating cost of muck removal, exhibitors will be charged £6 per stable to go towards the cost of this service. Extra SHAVINGS & HAYLAGE can be purchased in the Stable Field daily but deliveries to your stables will only be available on the Tuesday and Wednesday. Deliveries of forage and bedding from alternative suppliers will be strictly prohibited. Exhibitors are expected to leave their stables in a clean state - failure to do so may result in future expulsion from Hickstead. No horses or ponies may be kept in horseboxes overnight. Exhibitors who have not booked stabling will not be admitted to the Stable Field until the day of their competition. Stallion owners are required to bring their own electric packs. Unruly or dangerous animals may be asked to leave the showground.

9. STABLING DEPOSITS

- Please make sure you have a £20 CASH deposit for each stable to be given to the stable manager upon arrival. We will be operating a strict no cash deposit, no stable policy.
- This deposit will be reimbursed when leaving, on confirmation of a mucked out stable and on production of your deposit slip. **NO SLIP = NO RETURN OF DEPOSIT.** Clean shavings can be banked up on the back wall. We advise you to take a TIME & DATE STAMPED photo/video of your stable door and stable interior as proof to show the Stable Manager upon check out. Stables may also be inspected by the management team before the deposit is released.
- On arrival – if your stable is occupied, speak to the Stable Manager. DO NOT take occupancy of an empty stable without permission.
- Report existing damage or unusable condition to the Stable Manager. Some stables are in a used condition but should be skipped out.

10. HORSEBOXES

It is a requirement to put your mobile telephone number on your horsebox pass which must be displayed in the windscreen. It is prohibited for any exhibitor or associate to interfere with another exhibitor's horsebox.

11. RIDERS' CAR PARK

Exhibitors and visitors parking in the Riders' Car Park at the top of the Stable Field near the exit will be charged £15 per day or £45 for the week if purchased in advance.

12. CARAVANS AND LIVED-IN HORSE BOXES

There will be a limit of one caravan or one lived-in horse box per exhibitor for every three horses which they enter for the show. There will be no charge. Exhibitors with generators on their horseboxes must turn them off by 10.00pm. This ruling will be strictly enforced by Stable Field Security. Exhibitors who fail to comply with this ruling will be asked to leave the showground.

13. PARTIES AND INCONSIDERATE BEHAVIOUR IN THE STABLE FIELD

Hickstead has a no noise policy after 2300hrs meaning loud parties and gatherings after this time will not be tolerated. Children should not be allowed to roam free with water pistols, Segways & bikes. The Stable Field is a constant road network with HGVs using it 24/7 – it is not a playground! WH Management has our full authorisation to remove anyone not respecting these rules, forfeiting any remaining entries.

14. PRIZE MONEY

Prize money will be paid directly by BACS into your nominated bank account post show.

15. PHOTOGRAPHY & FILMING

No professional photography is allowed on the showground except with permission obtained from the Press Office. It is understood and agreed by any competitor attending the show that permission is granted to Hickstead Ltd for any photographs and/or film footage taken at the show by any official photographer or film company to be used by them for security, promotional, live streaming and/or broadcasting purposes, furthermore the competitor agrees that permission is without any payment.

16. **ANY COMPETITOR** found riding in the ring without permission will be disqualified from the show and reported to the Stewards of British Showjumping. All warming up must be done in the area provided. No one is allowed on the showground in the evenings or up to an hour before the first class in the morning. Any person riding their horses anywhere other than in the permitted areas will be subject to disciplinary action by the Executive and may be ordered off the showground.

17. The Executive reserves the right to use images of competitors at Hickstead for any promotional purpose.

18. The Executive reserves the right to cancel, add to, or amend any of the competitions as they think fit.
